

Skill Leader

General Purpose: Assist youth in skill development that will contribute to their success post-services. These can include basic life skills like cooking, budgeting, taxes, employment, applying for college, etc.

Essential Duties:

- Work with staff to identify needed skills workshops and develop appropriate workshop materials and “curriculum”
- Present the skill in a fun and engaging way, including hands-on application of the skill.

Can be a one-time presentation, recurring presentation, or a workshop completed over multiple weeks.
