Responsibilities

- Provides direct therapeutic mental health and addiction treatment (individual and group), education, case management, advocacy, referrals, and service coordination to adolescents, young adults, adult, and their families.
- Utilizes a trauma informed, motivational enhancement and cognitive behavioral model of therapy.
- Completes and maintains all required documentation within required timeframes consistent with format developed by program. Complies with all agency and contractual requirements for case record maintenance.
- Maintains positive and professional relationships with individuals and organizations involved with the target population, including referral sources and other community organizations for the purpose of care coordination.
- Maintains strict privacy and confidentiality practices in accordance with federal and state regulations, and consistent with ethical standards in the field.
- Delivers services in Child and Family Charities offices and remotely through telehealth as needed.
- Participates in individual clinical supervision, clinical team meetings, and clinical case conferencing.
- Attend ongoing professional training activities. Agency will provide a yearly stipend for professional training.
- Familiar with electronic medical record systems or ability to develop proficiency in a system for clinical documentation and case management purposes.

Qualifications

- Master's Degree in Social Work or Counseling.
- Limited License or Full Licensure. Agency will provide supervision for licensure.
- CADC/CAADC preferred or a development plan through MCBAP. Agency will provide supervision for licensure.
- Minimum one year of applicable experience in assessment and therapeutic interventions with adolescents, young adults, adults, and families required.
- Experience providing manual based therapy, addressing trauma, and knowledge working with the LGBTQIA2+ community a plus.
