Responsibilities

- Provides direct therapeutic substance use and/or mental health treatment (individual, group, and family therapy), education, case management, advocacy, referrals, and service coordination to adolescents, young adults, adult, and their families.
- Utilizes a trauma informed, motivational enhancement and cognitive behavioral model of therapy.
- Completes and maintains all required documentation within required timeframes consistent with format developed by program.
- Maintains positive and professional relationships with individuals and organizations involved with the target population, including referral sources and other community organizations, for the purpose of communicating and collaborating.
- Maintains strict privacy and confidentiality practices in accordance with federal and state regulations, and consistent with ethical standards in the field.
- Delivers services at Child and Family Charities offices, schools, as well as remotely through telehealth. You have the flexibility to work from home or the agency office.
- Participates in individual clinical supervision, clinical team meetings, and ongoing professional training activities. Agency will provide a yearly stipend for professional training.
- Familiar with Mid State Health Network policy and procedures as well as the REMI billing/authorization portal
- Familiar with electronic medical record systems or ability to develop proficiency in a system for clinical documentation and case management purposes.

Qualifications

- Master's Degree in Social Work or Counseling.
- Limited License or Full Licensure desired and CADC/CAADC preferred. Can have development plan through MCBAP. We will provide supervision for licensure and certification.
- Minimum one year of applicable experience in assessment and therapeutic interventions with adolescents, young adults, adults, and families required.
- Minimum one year of direct services providing substance use disorder treatment desired, but agency will provide training and support to grow in this area if experience is limited.
- Experience providing manual based therapy and addressing trauma a plus.
