SFP emphasizes the nurturing parenting skills of bonding, setting boundaries, and monitoring to keep their kids safe from alcohol and drug abuse; and trains kids to say "no" to harmful things and still keep their friends.

Families learn skills to:

- · Make their brains powerful and effective
- Notice and compliment the good daily
- Communicate respectfully
- Make family rules & positive routines
- Use Positive Discipline that really works
- Solve problems, negotiate differences, and help kids "pre-problem-solve" to stay safe
- · Reduce stress & apply good anger-management skills
- · Set goals to develop talents, enjoy school success
- Help kids avoid alcohol and drug use that can damage the teen developing brain
- Choose good friends, and monitor kids' social activities
- · Make fun family traditions, share values, give service
