Full Time School Based Clinical Therapist

Responsibilities

- Provide direct therapeutic services (individual, group, and family therapy), education, case management, advocacy, referrals, and service coordination to students and their families identified by Waverly Schools with a minimum caseload of 50 unduplicated clients per year.
- Be willing and able to provide evidence based therapeutic services with a Trauma Focus and ability to screen for ACE's (Adverse Childhood Experiences) or other acceptable screening tool.
- Utilize a trauma informed, motivational enhancement and cognitive behavioral model of therapy.
- Ability to screen for suicide risk and provide appropriate safety planning and crisis intervention as appropriate
- Completes and maintains all required documentation within required timeframes and consistent with format developed by program. Complies with all agency and contractual requirements for case record maintenance.
- Works with Child and Family Charities administration and Waverly administration/Student Support staff to
 initiate and assist in the development of innovative programming to meet the needs of the students and
 families to access care through acceptable means.
- Receive, track and follow-through with student referrals from the point of referral to initiation of services or appropriate conclusion of referral process.
- Well versed in technology platforms such as: Zoom, Skype and EMR.
- Maintain positive and professional relationships with individuals and organizations involved with the target population, including referral sources and other community organizations, for the purpose of communicating and collaborating with individuals and organizations.
- Maintains strict confidentiality in accordance with federal and state regulations, and consistent with ethical standards in the field.
- Deliver services within the Waverly Community Schools.
- Participates in individual clinical supervision, clinical team meetings and ongoing professional training activities

- Master's Degree in Social Work or Counseling.
- Full Licensure desired, but can have a limited license with over a year of experience.
- Minimum one year of applicable experience in assessment and therapeutic interventions with children, adolescents, and families required.
- Experience providing manual based therapy and addressing trauma required.
